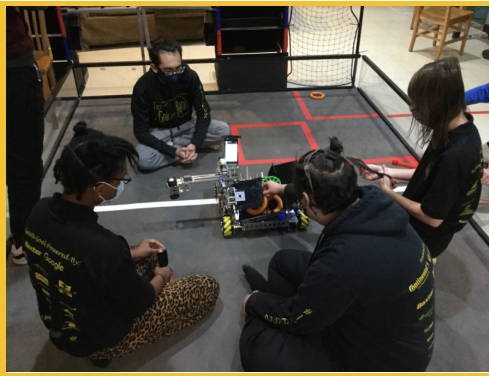


Who are FIRST Mentors?

- Someone who supports the team through answering programming or mechanical questions, building skills, assisting in scholarships, business management, marketing, and fundraising

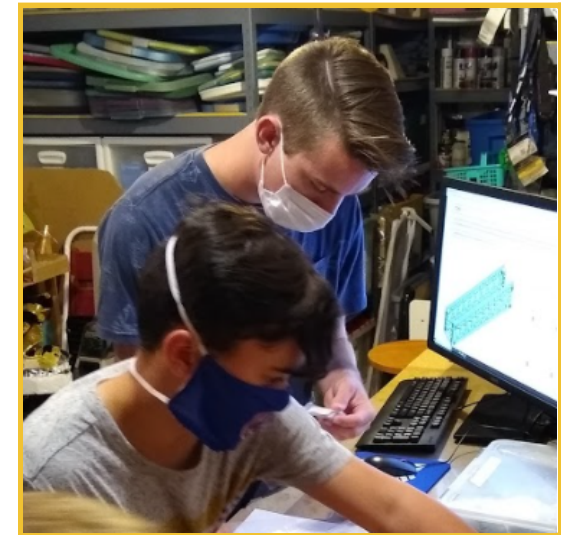


Why Mentor?
